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# BLOCK LOTTO

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## Modern Log Cabin Block

**BACKGROUND:** Kona Snow

**MAIN fabric:** Kaffe Fasset –Lavender Roman Glass

**ACCENT fabrics:** Any modern fabrics that coordinate with the MAIN fabric. Can be solid or prints.

This month's design is meant to be different with each block. You may start your block with the background or a main or an accent fabric. I will give you the measurements of all of 13 pieces within the block, but you will decide where to put the different fabrics and cut accordingly. With my first block, I cut the pieces as I sewed them together. You may use 2–5 pieces of color in your block (main and accent fabrics), the rest should be Kona Snow.

### STEP ONE:

You will need to start with 2 – 2 inch squares. Sew those together. Press seams open.



**STEP TWO:**

Cut your next two pieces: 2 – 2 x 3 1/2 inch rectangles. Working in a traditional log cabin style, sew on the next two pieces, pressing seams open.

**STEP THREE:**

Cut your next two pieces: 2 – 2 x 5 inch rectangles. Continue in traditional log cabin style, sew on ONE piece. At this point trim your block to 5 inches square. Now sew on your second piece, pressing seams open.

**STEP FOUR:**

Cut your next two pieces: 2 – 2 x 6 1/2 inch rectangles. Continue in traditional log cabin style, sew on both pieces, pressing seams open.

**STEP FIVE:**

Cut your next two pieces: 2 – 2 x 8 inch rectangles. Continue in traditional log cabin style, sew on ONE piece. At this point trim your block to 8 inches square. Now sew on your second piece, pressing seams open.

**STEP SIX:**

Cut your next two pieces: 2 – 2 x 9 1/2 inch rectangles. Continue in traditional log cabin style, sew on both pieces, pressing seams open.

**STEP SEVEN:**

Cut your next piece: 1 – 2 x 11 inch rectangle. Continue in traditional log cabin style, sew on and press seams open. Trim block to 11 inches square.



### GENERAL RULES:

- Blocks must be made of quilt shop quality, modern fabric.
- Blocks should be 11 inches square...MUST BE within 1/4 inch.
- You may make up as many blocks as you'd like this month. Each block gets one entry into the drawing. There is a \$1/block entry fee paid to the guild.
- If there are more than 24 blocks, we will split the pile in half and draw 2 names
- Please label your block with your name. (You may use an address label)
- If you have previously won, you must bring your FINISHED quilt made from your winning blocks in order to be eligible to win again. You may still contribute to the pool each month, if you'd like.
