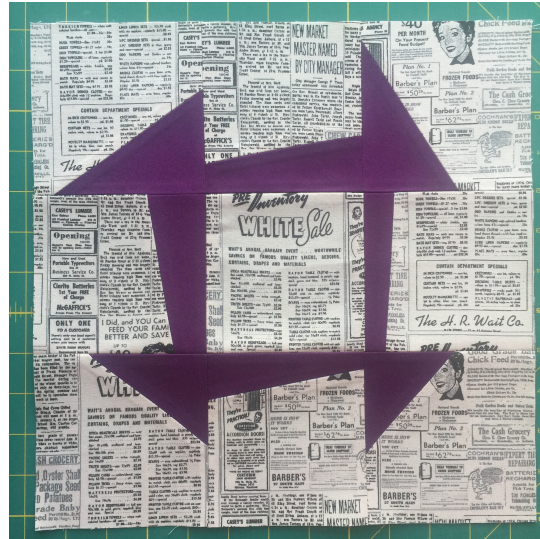


BLOCK LOTTO



STEP ONE:

Background fabric: Cut 9– 4.5 inch squares

Purple (solid or modern print): Cut:

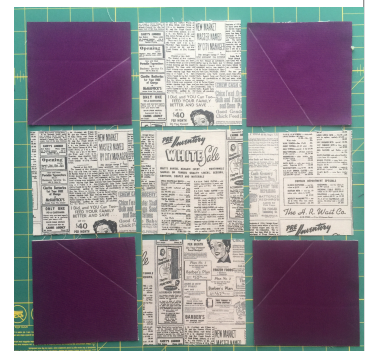
1– 3 inch strip LOF (length of fabric). If using a fat quarter, you may need to cut 2 strips.

4– 4.5 inch squares

STEP TWO:

Arrange your 9 background fabrics as shown. Then lay your 4 purple squares, right sides together, on each of the corner blocks. Mark your sewing line with a pen/pencil/chalk. Make sure the purple fabric will cover the triangle when flipped over. Then sew on that line.

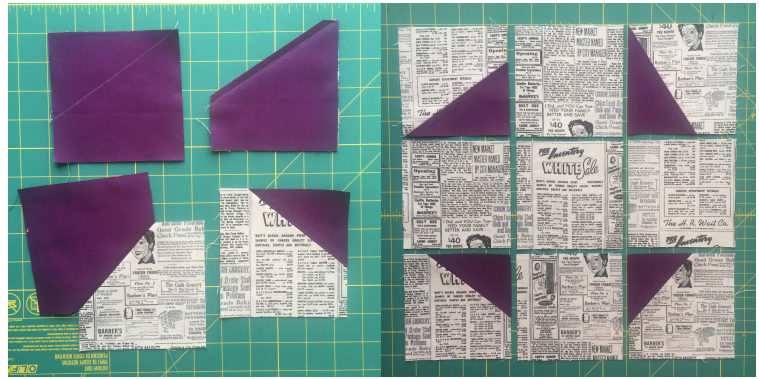
Tip: The background fabric is directional. Your choice if you want to drive your block lotto buddies crazy by not aligning them in the same direction!



STEP THREE:

Trim your block, flip the purple over and press seams open. Square up the block to a 4.5 inch square. Repeat to make all 4 corner blocks.

Tip: When pressing seams open, use spray starch. The seams will lay flat and help make your block more accurate!



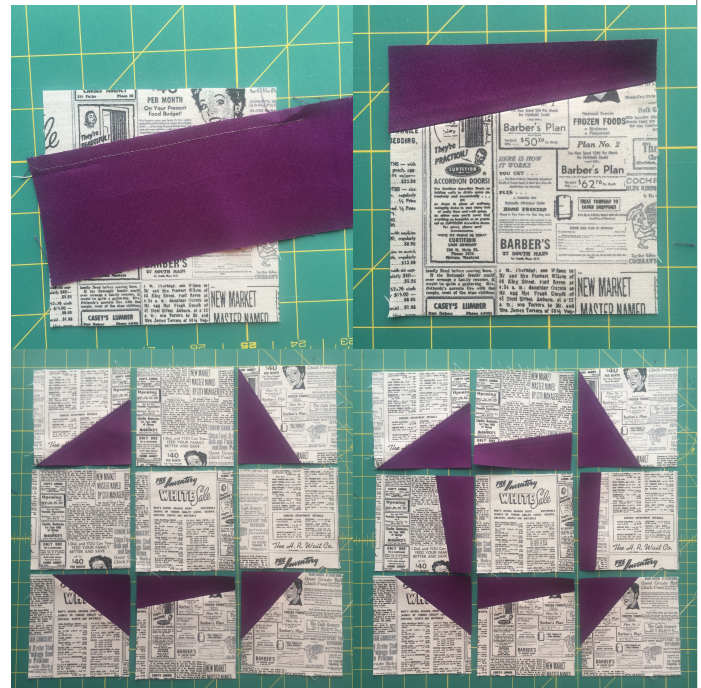
STEP FOUR:

Lay your purple strip on top of a background block, right sides together. Angle it to make it wonky.

Make sure that when you flip the strip it will cover the background square. Sew the purple strip to your block.

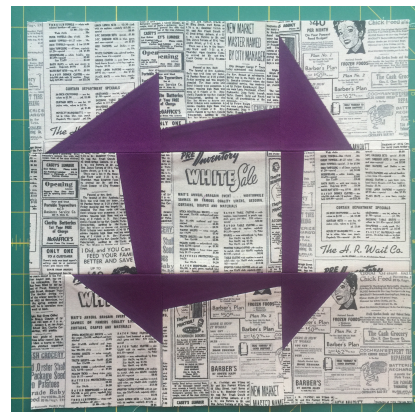
Cut the excess background fabric off. Cut off the purple strip. Trim your block to 4.5 inches square.

Repeat to make 4 blocks, note direction of background fabric.



STEP FIVE:

Sew block together, pressing seams open. Trim block to 12.5 inches square.



GENERAL RULES:

- Blocks must be made of quilt shop quality, modern fabric.
- Blocks should be 12.5 inches square...MUST BE within 1/4 inch.
- You may make up to 3 blocks/month. Each block gets one entry into the drawing. There is a \$1/block entry fee paid to the guild.
- If there are more than 24 blocks, we will split the pile in half and draw 2 names
- Please label your block with your name. (You may use an address label)
- If you have previously won, you must bring your FINISHED quilt made from your winning blocks in order to be eligible to win again. You may still contribute to the pool each month, if you'd like.
