
BLOCK LOTTO



“L” Block

STEP ONE:

- For the starting square and first “L” you may use any modern print or solid.
- For the 2nd “L” or last layer to your block, you must use a SOLID.
- Your final block will measure 10” x 10.”
- You choose how thick or thin each layer can be, EXCEPT, no layer or square may be less than 2 inches.
- No wonky blocks.



STEP TWO:

Begin to sew your first strip (print or solid) onto the left side of your square block (print or solid). Press seams open and square up your block.

**STEP THREE:**

Using the same strip as step two, sew the strip onto the bottom of your block. Press seams open and square up your block. Measure your block at this point, account for seam allowances and cut a strip of solid fabric wide enough to finish at a 10 inch square.

**STEP FOUR:**

Repeat steps 2 and 3 with a SOLID strip to create a second "L". Press seams open. Trim to 10" x 10" square.



GENERAL RULES:

- Blocks must be made of quilt shop quality, MODERN fabric.
- Blocks should be 10 inches square...MUST BE within 1/4 inch.
- You may make as many blocks as you'd like. Each block gets one entry into the drawing. There is a \$1/block entry fee paid to the guild.
- If there are more than 24 blocks, we will split the pile in half and draw 2 names
- Please label your block with your name. (You may use an address label)
- If you have previously won, you must bring your FINISHED quilt made from your winning blocks in order to be eligible to win again. You may still contribute to the pool each month, if you'd like.
