BLOCK LOTTO



BACKGROUND FABRIC: Light off white. Must be a solid.

MAIN FABRIC: Modern muted orange or green (may be patterned or solid).

STEP ONE:

Background fabric: Cut 1–7 inch square

1- 4 1/2 inch square

Main fabric: Cut 1-7 inch square

4-4 1/2 inch squares

STEP TWO:

Place the two 7 inch squares right sides together. Sew completely around your block with 1/4 inch seam allowance.



STEP THREE:

Cut on the diagonal twice. This should yield 4 HSTs blocks. Press seams open. SQUARE UP YOUR BLOCKS to 4 1/2 inch at this point.





STEP FOUR:

Arrange your block into the shoo-fly block pattern. Sew in column, then rows. Press seams open. SQUARE UP YOUR BLOCK to 12 1/2 inch square.

GENERAL RULES:

- Blocks must be made of quilt shop quality, modern fabric.
- Blocks should be 12.5 inches square...MUST BE within 1/4 inch.



- If there are more than 24 blocks, we will split the pile in half and draw 2 names
- Please label your block with your name. (You may use an address label)
- If you have previously won, you must bring your FINISHED quilt made from your winning blocks in order to be eligible to win again. You may still contribute to the pool each month, if you'd like.
