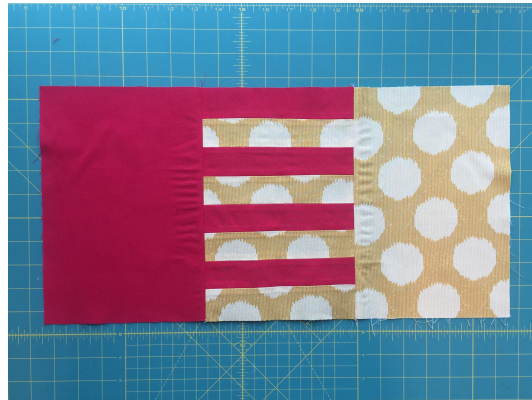

BLOCK LOTTO



Convergence Block

STEP ONE:

Choose two fabrics that are modern prints or solids in yellow, orange or red. You can have both solids, both prints, or a mix.

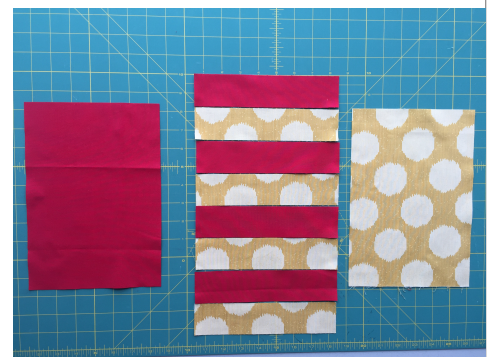
From each fabric cut:

- 1 – 7 inch x 10 inch rectangle AND
- 4 – 8 inch x 1 3/4 inch strips



STEP TWO:

Arrange your block with one 7 x 10 rectangle on the left and one on the right. Arrange the remaining strips in the middle, STARTING AT THE TOP with the SAME fabric as the rectangle on the LEFT.



STEP THREE:

Sew the middle strips together. Press all seams open.
Trim unit to 7 inches x 10 inches.

**STEP FOUR:**

Making sure that the top fabric on the strip unit matches the left rectangle, sew the rectangles together.
Your block should measure 10 inches x 20 inches. Trim if needed.

**GENERAL RULES:**

- Blocks must be made of quilt shop quality, modern fabric.
- Blocks should be 10 x 20 inches...MUST BE within 1/4 inch.
- You may as many blocks as you'd like. Each block gets one entry into the drawing. There is a \$1/block entry fee paid to the guild.
- If there are more than 24 blocks, we will split the pile in half and draw 2 names
- Please label your block with your name. (You may use an address label)
- If you have previously won, you must bring your quilt made from your winning blocks in order to be eligible to win again. You may still contribute to the pool each month, if you'd like.
