Corner Slash



You will need:

One 13" square of white low volume fabric

One 13" x 6" of a modern print any color (the size is dependant on how you slash your block.)

Step One:

Using a ruler slash off one corner of the block at an angle. Try not to come too close to the edge of the block or the seams will overlap with other block seams. Also, if you make your slash really deep you might need more than the 13 x 6" for the next step.



Step Two:

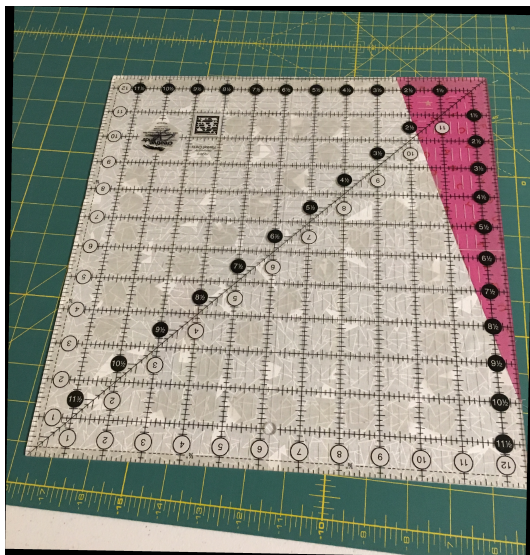
Take your 13" x 6" colored fabric. Lay it over your block and be sure you have about an inch overlap on the top and bottom and enough to cover the area that you slashed out of your block. Then sew the color on your slashed white low volume square. Press open.



Step Three

Trim your block to 12.5" x 12.5"

That's it, your done. This was so easy you might want to make more than one and up your chances of winning these great modern blocks.

- Blocks must be made of quilt shop quality, modern fabric.
- Blocks should be 12.5 inches square...MUST BE within 1/4 inch.
