
Corner Squares

Use quarter inch seams and press open

1. Start with a 12.5 inch square of low volume grey print.



2. Slice off the upper right hand corner making sure the long side is at least 10 to 10.5 inches. Save the fabric that was cut off.



3. Cut a 12 inch strip of black, either 2 or 2.5 inches wide. Add this strip of black to block in the upper right hand corner.



4. Take the original low volume piece that was previously cut and trim off a piece 1.5 inches in width from the long side of the triangle. Add this strip back on to the black in the upper right hand corner. After this cut, you will not use the small portion that is left of the low volume piece.



5. Cut a piece of a bright solid to be added to the upper right hand corner to make the block square again. You may have to cut at least a strip 5 by 9 inches, depending on the size of your black strips, to make your block to be 12.5 inches.



6. Square to 12.5 inches
