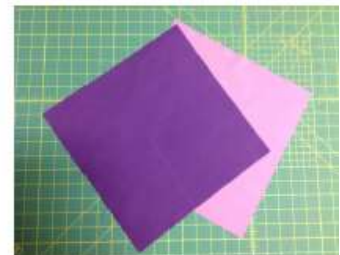


Wedge Block

These directions will make
2 – 10” unfinished blocks

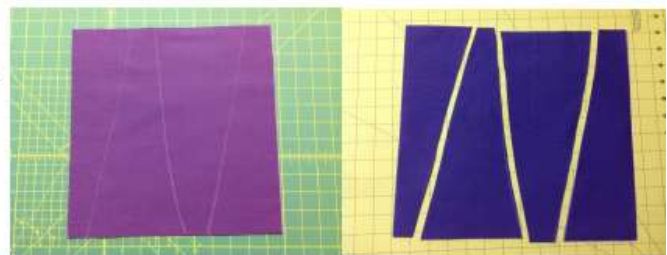
STEP ONE:

Fabric: Choose 2 solid fabrics in **ONE** color, one light and one dark. I used purple. (I know the light one looks pink!) Cut one 12 in square out of each fabric.



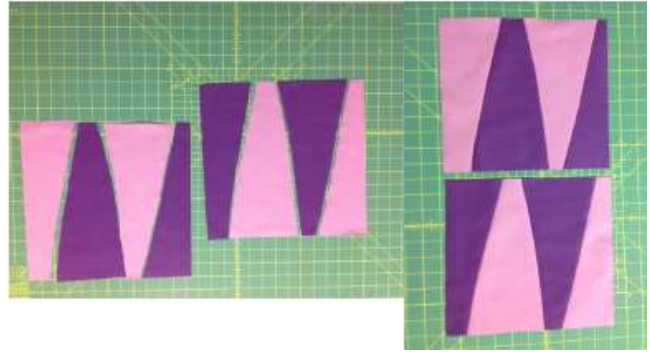
STEP TWO:

Place one square on top of the other. Make three diagonal cuts through the squares. You can cut them freehand or mark them first. No need to use a ruler.



STEP THREE:

Shuffle the pieces so the light and dark are alternating. Sew each block together.



STEP FOUR:

Press the seams open and trim the block to 10 inches square.

General Rules:

- Blocks must be made of quilt shop quality modern fabric – in this case, solids are used.
- Blocks should be 10" square (unfinished) – must be within $\frac{1}{4}$ ".
- Each block gets one entry into the drawing. There is a \$1/block entry fee paid to the build.
- If there are more than 24 blocks, we will split the pile in half and draw two names for the blocks.
- Please label your block with your name. (You may use an address label)
