As always, members attend the lecture for free, but we also have guest tickets available on our <a href="Event and Workshop">Event and Workshop</a> page of our website.


### March Show and Tell


### Block Lotto

#### Guidelines:

- Finished size--20" X 20"
- Use Cosmos in your ORIGINAL design a lot or a little somewhere on front of your Mini Quilt
- Finish your Mini Quilt with binding or facing
- Use at least one of the Modern Quilt Elements in design
  - Negative Space
  - Asymmetry
  - Improv
  - · Alternate Grid
  - Minimalism
  - · Modern Traditionalism
  - Scale-enlarged or reduced
- The quilting should enhance the modern design.

# Why Quilt?

You've been making quilts for months or years and have them all around your house. You can buy quilts to put on your bed for less money (and definitely less time) than ones you make. So, why do we make quilts?

Here's why I make quilts.

- 1. Quilting allows me to express my **CREATIVITY**. Quilting is an art form and a study of shapes and color.
- 2. Quilting brings me **JOY**. Designing a quilt, choosing a color palette, shopping for beautiful fabrics, cutting and sewing pieces together, and time with friends who love quilting too, bring me happiness.
- 3. Quilting keeps me a **LIFELONG LEARNER**. I am always learning new techniques, taking classes, using new tools, and keeping my skills current. There are new lessons to learn from every project and every mistake. All of these make me a better quilter.
- 4. Slicing fabrics and piecing them back together is **THERAPEUTIC**. While I'm quilting, I can concentrate on the process and forget the stresses of work or other things. I find myself becoming more relaxed after completing a block or finishing a quilt despite all of the other 1000 things that can be overwhelming in the world around me.
- 5. Quilts create **MEMORIES**. They are like a time capsule. Sometimes when I look at my quilts or photos of my quilts, memories bring me back to the time and place where I made them. The memories are even stronger when they are given as gifts to family and friends, knowing that the quilts are wrapping each of them in the love that I've sewn into each of my quilts.

So why do I quilt? There are several reasons but the bottom line is, quilts **keep people warm**. They may warm the body, but they also warm the heart. And what better way to keep your family and friends warm than under one of your own quilt creations while providing a needed hug anytime they need one!
